## Summary of Proceedings – 26<sup>th</sup> March 2014

### ***Recommendations from previous meetings***

- All weather access to aircraft at Gold Coast Airport – no new information was provided at this meeting.
- Committee to be updated on the ILS MDP – addressed later in the meeting agenda.
- Request for a joint presentation between Gold Coast Airport and Gold Coast City Council – this presentation was provided later in the meeting agenda.

### ***Airport Developments***

- Gold Coast Airport General Manager Aviation - Charles Martin discussed record airport passenger numbers for the month of January 2014. Charles also discussed the new Jetstar Gold Coast – Mackay daily services to start 28<sup>th</sup> June 2014.
- Gold Coast Airport Manager Operations and Standards - Brett Curtis provided an update on the ILS Major Development Plan – the MDP will likely be available for public comment within the next 4-6 weeks, advice will be provided once the MDP is available for view. A presentation was also provided by Brett giving technical information on the ILS installation and the equipment required.
- Gold Coast Airport Environment Manager Norbert Benton provided information on the environmental considerations involved with the ILS installation.

### ***AirServices Update***

- Aircraft Noise Information Reports are now available on the AirServices website.
- Neil Hall updated the Group on the proposed departure track over the Banora Point Golf Course.
- Neil also discussed Required Navigation Performance (RNP) and the proposed implementation at Gold Coast Airport.

### ***Other Business***

- A joint presentation was provided by Brett Curtis - Gold Coast Airport and David Hood - Gold Coast City Council focusing the Airport Master Plan and the Gold Coast City Plan and the connection between the two plans.
- Gold Coast Airport Property Manager – David White presented to the Group on the Major Development Plan for Southern Cross University – Building C.
- Justin Wastnage from the Tourism and Transport Forum provided a presentation on the changing mix of international travellers visiting the Gold Coast.

- Provide an all-weather access at the airport (an ongoing item).
