

Community Aviation Consultation Group

Summary of Proceedings – 22 June 2016

Recommendations from Previous Meetings

- Provide all-weather access at the airport - ongoing item.
- Airservices to confirm the accuracy of the flight path flown in the RWY 34 Golf Course Trial.

Airport Developments

Gold Coast Airport General Manager Operations and Service Delivery, Brett Curtis, provided an update on airport operations:

- An appeal has been lodged with the Administrative Appeal Tribunal to review the Minister's decision to approve the ILS MDP. Associated with this appeal, an application for a Stay of Works has also been lodged with the AAT. A decision on the Stay application is expected next week, accordingly no physical works for the ILS will commence until a decision on the Stay application is known.
- Works on the Southern Cross University Building C have begun with completion expected early 2017.
- GCAPL have started the preparation of the 2017 preliminary draft Master Plan as the current 2011 Master Plan is due to expire in May 2017. A 60 Business day Public Consultation on the preliminary draft Master Plan is expected to commence mid-October. A detailed presentation on the contents of the preliminary draft Master Plan will be provided in the next CACG Meeting.

A presentation was provided to the Group on 'Project Lift' and the Major Development Plan.

Neil Hall - Airservices Update

Neil Hall delivered a presentation to the group on the Aircraft Navigation Modernisation Program. Information pamphlets were left for the group.
