# 6. General Aviation (GA)

## **PelAir Operations**

Chair introduced Wally Myer and PelAir Operations and what is happening in regards to night freight and the Westwind aircraft.

Wally from PelAir provided a background on operations and aircraft used since 1978. PelAir currently operating under their legal requirements in relation to flight path. Wally aware of request to follow the Fly Neighbourly Policy and is more than willing to work with the committee.

JS asked Wally if the Westwind Aircraft met the chapter 6 noise requirement. Wally stated that it did not but the Westwind Aircraft was one of the exempt aircraft as stated within the legislation.

TS asked Wally as to why impulse could fly the adapted noise abatement procedures and still fly as per the regulations as they conducted similar business to PelAir and why PelAir could not? Wally's reply was that he is doing exactly what is required in the DAP as issues by AirServices Australia.

## Chair summarised the comments:

Request PelAir Performance Engineer to review the current 14 Departure procedures and the Impulse Departure procedure to achieve a procedure that is acceptable to all ANACC members..

JA added that Global Jet services may also use the same departure procedure as PelAir.

**Motion:** Recommended by NW that Pel Air be requested to initiate a 14 departure procedure that is acceptable to the community and is similar to the Impulse 14 Departure procedures.
